WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

REGISTRATION

Entrants are encouraged to register as far in advance as possible although entries will be accepted the day of the event up to noon. Registration fee is \$15.00 per vehicle until June 1, 2011, \$18.00 per vehicle thereafter. A customized Mule Days t-shirt is available for entrants that may be ordered when you send back our registration form.

INSURANCE

Proof of insurance forms as required by the State of Washington are required. A copy of your insurance coverage must be attached to your entry form.

START/CHECK IN

All entrants are encouraged to "show off" their vehicles in the parade although it is not a requirement to participate in the Car Show itself. Line up for the parade by two's is reserved for you south of the Reardan Post Office. You may line up any time after 8 a.m. The parade begins at approximately 10:15 a.m. with the car show

immediately afterwards. After driving the length of the parade proceed to Roberts Park for the Show 'n Shine and judging.

FACILITIES

The car show is located in the heart of town in Roberts Park across from the Post Office. All vehicles are parked following the parade when the judging will begin.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to vehicles divided into three categories for 2011: *Factory Stock* (All Years), *Antique* (1942 & Older) and *Hot Rod* (All Years). The *Antique* and *Hot Rod* categories will be divided into "Professional Restored" and "Owner Restored" divisions. (Owner restored means that you complete 75% of the work yourself.) *Factory Stock* and *Hot Rod* will be individual categories. A *Peoples Choice Trophy* is awarded to the vehicle that gets the most votes as cast by the viewing public. Every entry receives a 2011 customized dash plaque from Reardan Mule Days. Awards are presented at 1:30 p.m.

MULE CHASE FUN RUN



Runners kick off the day early Saturday, June 4th when Jack sets the pace on the course of the 5K and 10K runs early in the morning. Race/walk starts at 8:00 am on June 4th at Joe B. Johnston Field at Reardan High School. All full entry participants receive a custom designed t-shirt.

KIDDIE & GENERAL PARADES

Saturday morning, June 4th at 10:15, children will lead off the main parade that promises to be even larger than last year's record turn out. Entries from all over the state take part and in addition to Jack's relatives (herd) they will be joined by car owners, floats, bands, motorcycles, bikes antique/restored tractors, steam equipment, horses, wagons and a few surprises along the route. All children who enter get free ice cream!

Our annual kid's carnival and fun fair will be on the grass in front of the high school and features games, inflatables, bouncy houses and a Fast Pitch Booth.

Hot Hoops (3 on 3) basketball for all ages will be featured on the street in front of the high school. A favorite of everyone, it is a great warm up for Hoopfest! Teams are comprised of three or four members and each participant receives a custom designed t-shirt as a part of their entry fee.

DANCES & BEER GARDEN

Teenagers will have a great time Friday night dancing to music played by a DJ. Grown-ups can kick up their heels to a live country and western band Saturday night in the Community Hall/Beer Garden. The beer garden will feature our famous local beer. You'll love it!

Our 19th annual car show is divided into three categories: *Factory Stock* (All Years), *Antique* (1942 & Older), *Hot Rod* (All Years). A *People's Choice Trophy* is awarded to the vehicle that gets the most votes as cast by the viewing public. Every entry receives a custom designed dash plaque.
